313709	Brindle, Regina (Reich)	Carl Gaus	Regina received a widow's pension, in the amount of \$8 per month, beginning November 2, 1891 for the service of her husband, Albert Brindle (1828-1883).
108944	Weaver, Jacob J.	Mary W. Bookout	last received a pension of \$25 until his death August 3, 1918 in Lynn Haven, FL. Jacob was a Corporal in Co. C. 54th Pa Inf and was injured when hit in the foot with a minnie ball. His widow-WEAVER, Matila Jane (CRUM) received pension #888669, in the amount of \$40 per month until Dec. 4, 1931 because of her death.
764891	Weaver, Jesse E.	Mary W. Bookout	was a Private with Co. A 81st Infantry, PA Volunteers, enlisting at Hollidaysburg, Pa. Jesse drew a pension of \$10 until his death at which time his wife Susan (Brown) Blanchard WEAVER collected his pension. Jesse was a native of Wilmore and South Fork.
unknown	Williams, George Albert	Tracey Williams	He enlisted in Co. C 19th Battalion, U.S. Infantry in Ebensburg, on Sept 28, 1861, and was discharged at or near Atlanta, GA. on Sept 28, 1864. Expiration of enlistment. He died June 7, 1922, in Jamestown, NY. The notice to discontinue his payments indicates he was receiving \$50.00 a month at the time of his death.
