

CALVIN HENRY MOORHEAD,

Deputy Controller of Northumberland County and prominent leader in church, athletic and political affairs of that area, died October 29.

Mr. Moorhead was 71 years old. He was admitted to Community Hospital of Sunbury October 20th following a stroke.

Survivors are his wife and sons: John L. Moorhead, Durham, N. C.; Charles A. Moorhead, Bogota, Colombia, South America, and David Porter Moorhead, Sunbury; a brother, William Moorhead, Indiana, Pa.; sisters: Mrs. Herbert Smith, Johnstown, and Mrs. W. H. Brown, of Toronto, Ohio. *10-31-1952*

Mr. Moorhead was one of Pennsylvania's all-time great athletes, starting there in football, basketball and baseball. He was a pioneer in the development of high school athletics of Pennsylvania.
