

**J. REPELL "PEL" MOORHEAD, 80,** of Raleigh, N.C., died Saturday, March 18, 1989, at Raleigh.

The son of William Q. and Nova L. Moorhead, he was born April 6, 1908, in Indiana.

Mr. Moorhead had been a longtime member of Graystone Presbyterian Church, Indiana, and had served on the Session. He was a past president of the Kiwanis, and a member of the F&AM Lodge 313, Coudersport Consistory and the Jaffa Temple.

Mr. Moorhead had been a solicitor for Indiana Borough and was the oldest living member of the Indiana County Bar. In 1975, he retired from the Rochester and Pittsburgh Coal Co. where he had been chief counsel. Mr. Moorhead graduated from Indiana Area High School and Muskingum College. He received his bachelor of law degree from the University of Pittsburgh Law School.

Surviving are his wife, Gertrude Caylor Moorhead; two daughters: Mrs. Anne Oliver, Raleigh; Dr. Carol Simpson, Alexandria, Va.; three grandchildren; one sister, Carol L. Moorhead; and one brother, William P. Moorhead.
