

JEANNETTE MOORHEAD

Jeannette Moorhead, daughter of Alexander Thompson and Mary Jane Hutchison Moorhead was born in Indiana, Pennsylvania, May 16, 1861. After finishing her education in the Indiana Public Schools, she worked with her father who was serving an eight year term as Postmaster of Indiana. On December 31, 1889 she married David Kuntz Hill of Leechburg, Pennsylvania. Their early married life was spent in Leechburg where Mr. Hill was Editor and Publisher of the local newspaper—"The Leechburg Advance." Two daughters were born to them; Margaret and Sara Katherine. The family moved to Tulsa, Oklahoma and some years later to Ann Arbor, Michigan. Mrs. Hill died in Ann Arbor July 31, 1943 and Mr. Hill on March 1, 1947. Burial was made in the family lot in Leechburg, Pennsylvania.
