Forkston Cemetery Inquiry of Ms Ria Valenzi

The complete list of graves for the Forkston Cemetery was compiled and put on the Internet in July of 2012. A dedicated website was created for the Forkston Cemetery Associate. Links were provided on the Association's main page to Find-A-Grave and to a pre-existing page of headstones. At that time in 2012, of the 925 souls buried in the Forkston Cemetery, only 510 were recognized by the linked listing of headstones posted on the Sullivan County website. Even fewer were recognized by the Find-A-Grave link. Of these remaining 415 souls, particularly those buried prior to July of 1890, a number of them have undocumented headstones. And many simply have no marker above their grave.

Now, to answer the questions posed in your e-mails:

1. In regards to the date of death for Musa N. Springer of January 2, 1982, I can see where the year of death was likely 1983 instead of 1982. The entries in this Burial Registry book are sequenced by date of death. And the two dates that immediately preceding the entry for Musa Springer are: February 13 and March 14, 1892. The dates after Musa Springer's entry are February 4 and April 19, 1893. This is likely a transcription error on my part. (I do not have access to this source book at this time. Only the spreadsheet.)

2. In regards to Annis Harford, her age is listed as 55, with the year of death listed as 1892. The year is shown as ditto marks here, with 1892 listed on the line above.

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3. In regards to Addie Wilson, I now see the first name was not Eddie. I mistook the "A" as a stylized "E". I did, however, use Addie in the spreadsheet columns to the left.


