Married at the residence of the brides parents, on Carpenter street, on the evening of February 25, by Rev. J.W. Klingler; David Cook, of Bernice, and Miss Margaret McHenry daughter of MR. And Mrs. William McHenry of this place. Miss Pearl McHenry served as bridesmaid and Judson E. Harney was best man.

TAKEN FROM THE SULLIVAN REVIEW NEWSPAPER:FEBRUARY 27,1902 "Margaret McHenry and David Cook were married at the home of the bride's parents, on Carpenter Street,Dushore,Pa, on February 25, 1902, by a Reverend J.W.Klingher. Margaret is the daughter of Mr. & Mrs. William McHenry of Dushore,Pa. Miss Pearl McHenry served as the bridesmaid and Judson E. Harney was the best man."

TAKEN FROM THE SULLIVAN REVIEW: Wednesday, January 11, 1928 Obit of David Cook David Cook died Friday evening, January 6th at his home on German Street , of heart failure at the age of 49 years old. He was born in South Dakota and when he was about 12 years of age he came to Bernice,Pa , with his family. For many years he has been employed by the Connell Coal company of Bernice. He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Margaret Cook, and ten children; Karl Cook of Johnson City,N.Y.; Mrs. Josephine Eilenberger of Rochester, N.Y.; Douglas,Alice, Gerald, Bernice, Kathryn, Pearl, Martha and Doris of this place. Also two sisters, Mrs. H.J.Schaad and Mrs. George Driscoll of Mildred,Pa.; and five brothers, Archie Cook of Denver, Col., Thomas Cook of Douglass,Wyoming; John Cook of Reynoldsville; Charles Cook of Sayre; and William J. Cook of Mildred. Funeral services was held Monday afternoon at his late home in Dushore, which was largely attended. Rev. W. H. Fehr officiated. Interment was made in Bahr Hill cemetery.

Notes for Margaret JOHNSTON-216:

According to the 1900 census for Bernice, PA, Margaret Cook was born in Scotland in 10/1840, and was widowed at the time of the census. She had two children, David and Mary, who were born in Iowa. Her obituary, written January 13, 191, states that Margaret died suddenly at her home after returning from church. She fell unconscious after complaining of terrible pains in her head. It was thought she died of a stroke. She was survived by six sons and four daughters. A.D. Cook and Thomas Cook of Douglas, Wyoming; Mrs. Carrie Peacock of Boone, Iowa; Mrs Fred Brown of Clifton Springs; John Cook of Reynoldsville; William and Charles, Mrs Henry Schaad and Mrs. George Driscoll of Mildred; and David Cook of Dushore.

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
